Assistive Technology

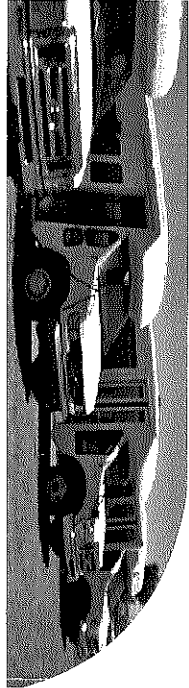
We will assist you in selecting and applying for FREE or low-cost assistive telecommunication devices.

We provide low-cost (and sometimes free), accessible transportation to those in the Quad City area.

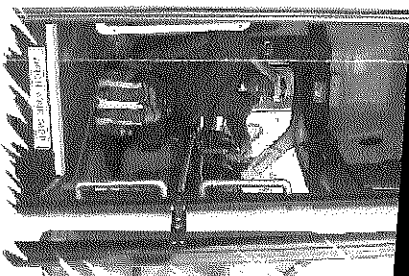
For rides to work, school, appointments, social engagements, shopping or prescription pick-up, please call 928-775-8870 to schedule a ride 72 hours in advance.

We provide one-on-one assistance for residents of Apache, Coconino, Mohave, Navajo and Yavapai Counties.

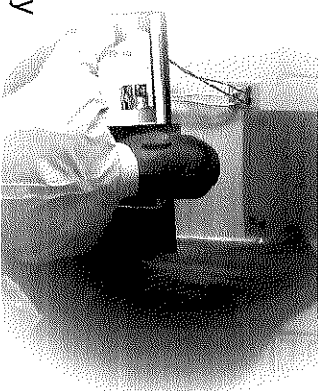
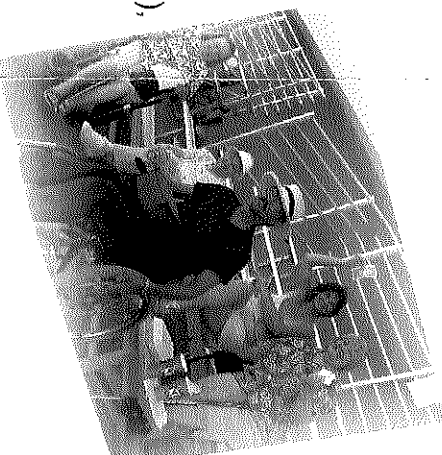
Visitors are welcome to utilize our computers. Internet access and onsite classes are available.

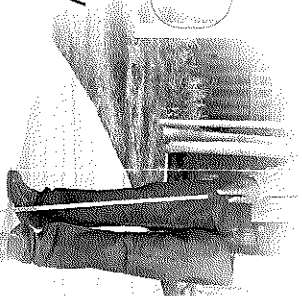
